Regular review of care plans may be helpful

Most common complex presentations

Agitation and Aggression Anxiety Apathy **Nocturnal Disruption Psychosis** Inappropriate Sexual Behaviour Family Dynamic Issues



Agitation in a 77yr old

No diagnosis

Rarely seen in clinical setting

Becoming increasingly aggressive and agitated at home

No ACD in place

No POA in place



Apply a person centred approach

Consider utilising a Multi-disciplinary approach

Consider ethical and legal considerations



Lives alone at home with wife Wife priority is to keep him home as long as possible

Met by me in 2022 April – provided a diagnosis Commenced on SSRI and Memantine Referred to ACAT Attempted social support at home Out of home Respite

Referral to GEM team in SALHN

Continued support – for me and for family

Too late for ACD/Care planning



Family meeting with son arranged Person centred Multi-Disciplinary
